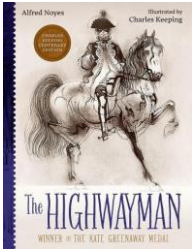


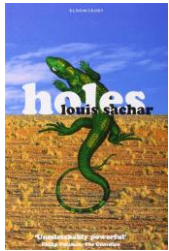
Class 4 Learning Snapshot

Autumn 1 - 2025

ENGLISH



This half term, the children will be reading the classic poem, 'The Highwayman' by Alfred Noyes and modern novel, 'Holes' by Louis Sachar, both linked to the school value of Justice and our history unit of Crime and Punishment. During these sessions, the children will explore characters' behaviours, motives and the resulting consequences.



MATHS

In maths this half term, children in Year 5 and 6 will be learning about place value of numbers to a million and beyond! Once secure, the children shall begin to refine and develop their methods for both mental and written calculations for each of the four number operations. Within each session, the children will have opportunities to develop their mathematical fluency skills, as well as developing their reasoning and problem-solving skills.
