

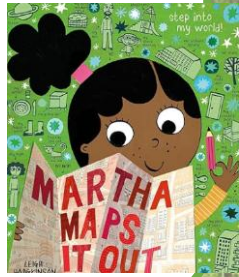
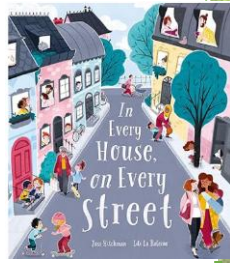
# Class 2 Learning Snapshot

## ENGLISH

Class 2 are working hard to ALWAYS produce a 'HIGH FIVE SENTENCE'. This includes... capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, using phonics to sound out words and reading their sentence back to check it makes sense.

We will be using these fantastic books to practice our writing skills and delve deeper into characters thoughts and feelings along their journey.



## MATHS

Children will be following the White Rose Scheme of Learning. In Autumn term the children will be focusing on Place Value (within 20).

The children will learn how to:

- Recognise and write numbers to 20.
- Count forwards and backwards.
- Understand ten
- Understand tens and ones
- Use number lines
- Use comparison symbols to compare numbers

The children will have opportunity to develop their mathematical fluency as well as learn reasoning and problem-solving skills.
