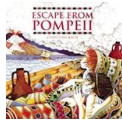


Class 3 Learning Snapshot

Spring 2- 2026

ENGLISH

In English this half term, the children will be focusing on the book ***Escape from Pompeii*** by Christina Balit. They will use drama to immerse themselves in the story and will focus on their senses and prepositions to write a setting description. They will develop their use of figurative language, such as similes and metaphors, to create imagery. The children will explore the main characters, including how their feelings change throughout the story. They will also write their own play scripts and a historical story inspired by their learning.



MATHS

This half term, both year groups will be learning about fractions before Year 3 move on to mass and capacity, and Year 4 begin their work on decimals.

All children have a TT Rockstars login so they can practise at home. (Logins can be found in the back of reading diaries). **Year 4 children have their statutory Times Tables Check in June**, so regular weekly practice is especially important.
