

Class 3 Learning Snapshot

Summer 2 - 2026

ENGLISH

In English this half term, the children will be exploring myths and legends. They will develop their understanding of this genre by reading a range of myths, legends, fables and traditional tales, identifying and discussing their key features and common themes. The class will then study *The Pied Piper of Hamelin*, exploring the text in detail through character descriptions and grammar-focused lessons. Following this, the children will rewrite the story as a narrative before planning and writing their own original stories inspired by the style and features of myths, legends and fables.



MATHS

In Maths this half term, both year groups will be learning about shape and statistics. The children will learn about different angles and be able to compare them. They will learn facts about 2D and 3D shapes and extend their knowledge of vertices, faces and edges. Year 4 will learn how to plot coordinates on a grid and describe translations.



All children have a TT Rockstars login so they can practise at home. (Logins can be found in the back of reading diaries).
