

Class 4 Learning Snapshot

Summer 1 - 2026

ENGLISH

This half term, the children will be reading Eva Ibbotson's 'Journey to the River Sea', making links to their previous geography learning. During our grammar sessions, the children will be revisiting their prior learning and developing their understanding of grammatical terminology. In our writing sessions, we will be exploring the use of descriptive language, using film clips, such as, 'The Present' as a writing stimulus.

MATHS

In maths this half term, children in Year 5&6 will be learning about shape, including calculating angles and using a protractor. The children will then learn about units of measure and how to convert measurements of length/distance, mass and capacity, using their knowledge of place value. Year 6 will also be revisiting their previous learning in revision sessions to fully prepare for their upcoming SATs. *For more information regarding SATs including dates, please click the following link:
