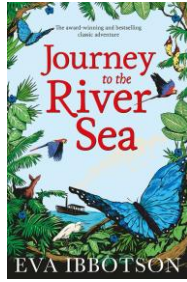


# Class 4 Learning Snapshot

## Summer 2 - 2026

### ENGLISH



This half term, the children will continue reading Eva Ibbotson's 'Journey to the River Sea', making links to their previous geography learning. In this unit, they will explore descriptive language used to introduce characters and settings, before writing their own narratives inspired by the plot. This half term, the children will be developing their editing and improving skills, using ICT to support them.

### MATHS

In maths this half term, children in Year 5 will be revisiting written methods for the four number operations, before developing their skills when deciphering multi-step problems. Children in Year 6 will begin to apply a variety of mathematical skills to projects and real-life scenarios, where they will collaboratively and creatively.
