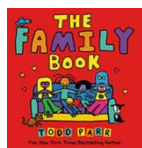
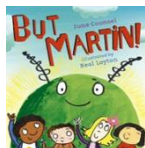


Robin Class Learning Snapshot

Autumn 1 - 2026

Marvellous Me!



This term, we will focus on helping the children settle into their new classroom, build secure relationships and develop a strong sense of identity and belonging. We will explore ourselves, our families, feelings, similarities and differences, as well as the people and places that are familiar to us.

Through stories, songs, play and hands-on experiences, the children will discover more about their bodies and senses and begin to notice the changes that autumn brings.

Our learning will be revisited and embedded throughout the term through our daily routines, continuous provision and caring interactions, supporting the children to grow in confidence, independence and curiosity as they begin their Early Years journey.

Maths

This term, **Nursery** will focus on counting and subitising numbers to 1-3, while exploring and recognising simple 2D shapes. **Reception** will begin by revisiting the key counting principles, building confidence with accurate counting and developing an understanding of numbers and quantities.
